Extended panels are recommended for a multi-layer system over a concrete or metal deck where adhesive is used. Below is a typical comparison to show the savings.

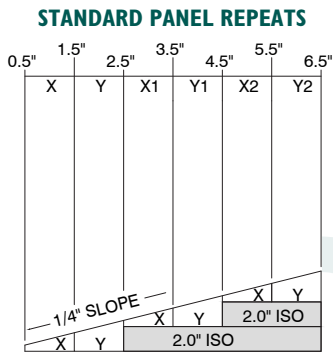
- Below is a cost comparison on a standard and extended panel repeat. Job specifications are as follows:
- Roof Area: 475 squares
 - Tapered Insulation Slope: 1/4" per ft
 - 1/2" min @ Drains - 13" High Point

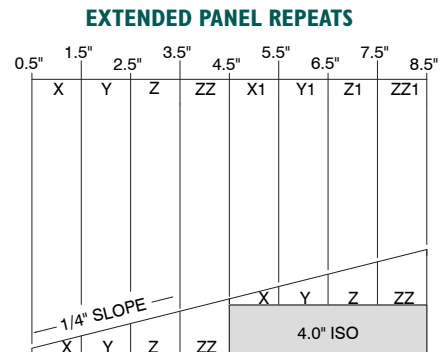


EXTENDED PANEL SYSTEM

Extended Panel Repeat: X, Y, Z, ZZ, 4" - 4" Fill Required – 402 squares

Extended Product Quote \$ 100,800
 Adhesive Costs: \$ 14,070
 (402 Squares of fill x \$35)
